We encourage all our guests to be responsible visitors and there are seven things you can do to help save the planet:

Conserve energy - switch off lights and keep the windows closed if heating is on. Turn the radiators down if it is too warm for you. The Energy Saving Trust provides information on what you can do at home.

Give the car a rest, if only for a day. Walk, cycle or use public transport.

Shop locally - buy and use local products. We are fortunate to have some fantastic producers of food, drink, and arts and crafts in Hampshire. Pick up a Hampshire's Local Produce guide; they are free.

Reduce, Reuse, Recycle - try to avoid overly packaged goods and say no to that extra carrier bag; instead pick up a "Bag for Romsey" and enjoy your day. Try and recycle any waste you have in your personal recycle basket or bin. We recycle or compost as much as we can.

Be water wise - turn off the tap when brushing your teeth and keep showers short. We do not have a towel policy; we just air them so they smell of our lovely fresh Hampshire air.

Respect Nature - help us to look after the landscape and wildlife by not littering, guarding against fire and using footpaths and cycle-ways responsibly. Leave no Trace.
